

BOOSTS READING CONFIDENCE!

With this picture of the day routine, students will get a chance to “read the picture” and practice applying key comprehension skills, without having to read an actual text.

How does Picture of the Day Work?

- Students study the picture.
- They apply the comprehension skill to that picture.
- Students respond in writing or discuss their ideas with the class.

OPTION I: PowerPoint Presentation

Includes a PowerPoint presentation that can be displayed on a smartboard. This works great if you want to use picture of the day as part of your reading warm-up routine or even as part of your morning meeting discussion.

OPTION 2: Student Worksheet

Another option is to print the student worksheets and let students do picture of the day independently. Works great as part of morning work routine.

Three overlapping student worksheets titled "PICTURE OF THE DAY: Summarizing" are shown. Each worksheet includes a photo, a name and date field, and several text boxes for student responses.

Worksheet 1 (Left): Photo of a man and a woman jogging. Questions include: "What is happening in the photograph?", "Why might the people in the photograph be running?", and "Summarize what is happening in the photo..."


Worksheet 2 (Middle): Photo of students in a line outside a building wearing masks. Questions include: "Who do you see in the photograph?", "When would students form a line outside of a building?", and "Summarize what is happening in the photo..."

Worksheet 3 (Right): Photo of students cheering with pom-poms. Questions include: "What are the people doing in the photograph?", "Where are the people in the photograph?", "Why do you think the people in the photograph are celebrating?", and "Summarize what is happening in the photo..."

OPTION 3: Half-Page Task Cards

You can also print them as half-page task cards. You can put them on a ring or laminate and use in a literacy center.
