Examples for phon:

Word	Word Parts	Definition
microphone	micro + phon(e) (small + sound)	a device that changes sound into an electrical signal
megaphone	mega + phon(e) (giant + sound)	a cone-shaped device used to make one's voice louder
homophone	homo + phon(e) (same + sound)	words that sound the same but have different spellings
phonics	phon + ic(s) (sound + study)	the method of teaching reading
cacophony	cac(a) + phon(y) (bad + sound)	harsh discordant sound

Examples for spec/spect:

Word	Word Parts	Definition
spectate	spect + ate (see + to be)	to watch or observe
spectacle	re + spect (again + see)	to regard
inspection	Intro + spect(ion) (inward + see)	a view of the inside or interior
spectacle	in + spect (into + see)	to look upon
retrospective	retro + spect(ive) (backwards + see)	looking backward
expect	ex + (s)pect (away from + see)	to look forward to or to await something

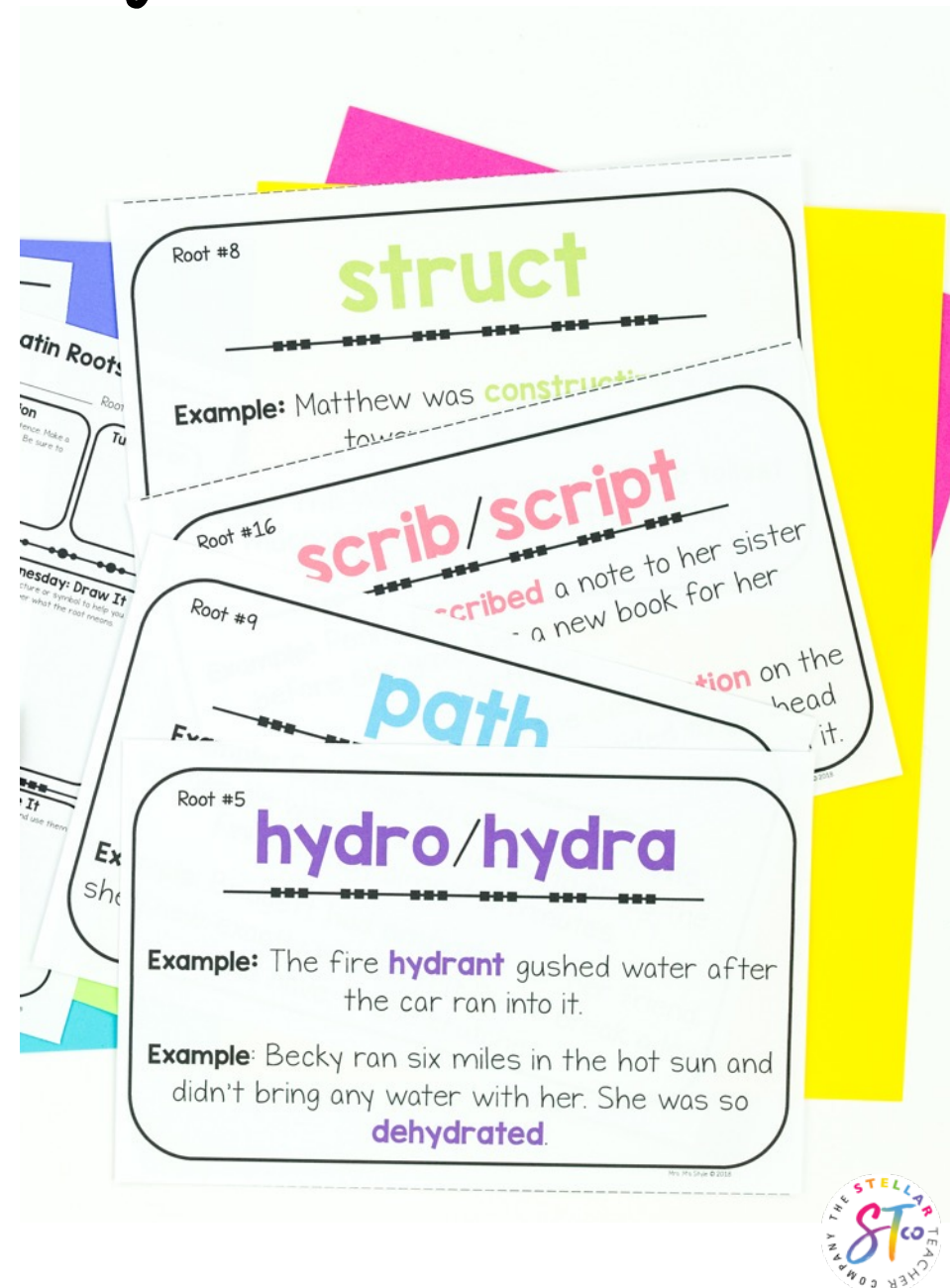

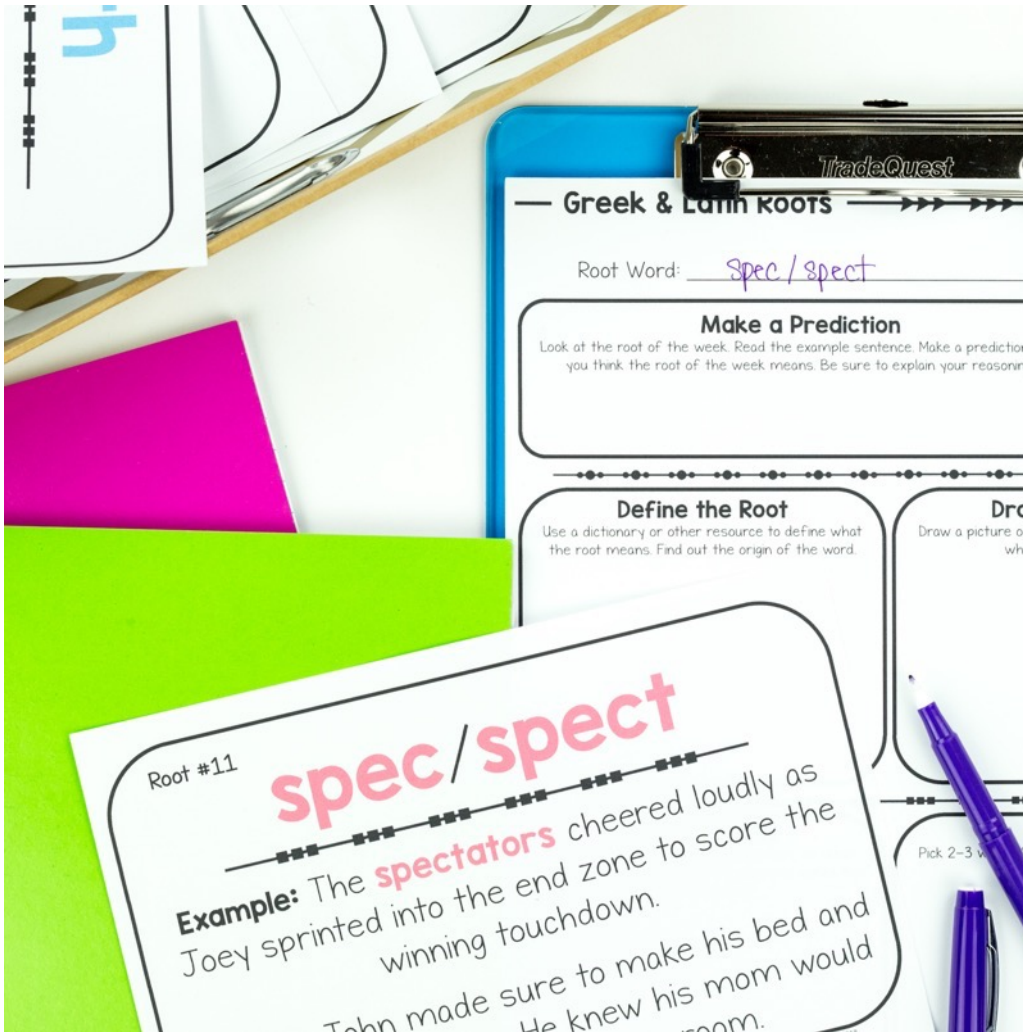
